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Discipline Policy (revised 2017)

Students are expected to follow all school and class rules at all times. This includes class time, break time, after school club time or any activity that is held at the school.

For minor offenses (e.g. Talking out of turn, dropping litter, not doing homework)

- The classroom teacher will have a conversation with the student and make sure that the student understands what the problem is and how his/her behavior will need to change
- If the behavior continues, the student may lose break time
- If the behavior becomes chronic, the student will be sent to have a discussion with the Head of Primary or Secondary

For serious offenses such as

1. Swearing in any language
2. Physical injury to another person (excluding accidents)
3. Vandalism of property, school or another person's
4. Stealing
5. Bullying, whether it is verbal, written or done via electronics(cyberbullying)
6. Insubordination, refusing to follow directives teachers/staff members

Students will be sent to the office immediately. Parents will be informed. Consequences could include suspension and or expulsion.
